SHOW SCHEDULE

THEME: "Cymbidium Circus"

Friday – March 3rd - Noon to 6:00 p.m, Exhibit and Vendor Setup; RIBBON JUDGING, 7:00 p.m.

Saturday – March 4th - 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. Vendor Setup. 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Open to the Public.

Sunday – March 5th - 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m, Open to the Public. Vendor and Exhibit Breakdown 4:00 p.m.

All Rules described below will be strictly enforced in the interest of this show and fairness to its participants. Please review carefully.

EXHIBITOR RULES:

Member must be in good standings.

Plants, floral arrangements and artistic exhibits must be entered on Friday from Noon through 6:00 p.m. with all proper entry forms completed. For participation in the Floral Arrangement Classification, one must preregister with the show chairperson by the general membership meeting prior to the show so we can plan the space requirements in the show room. ALL plants, floral arrangements and artistic exhibits may not be removed from the premises before the close of the show at 4:00 p.m. Sunday.

Teams of judges will conduct the ribbon judging. Judges cannot judge in the classification they belong to (Novice, Intermediate, Advanced or Open/Commercial) or vote for their own plants. If so, he/she will be asked to leave the judging room. Judges may withhold trophies or ribbons if in their opinion, some or all plants in a category are not good enough for awards. Clerks and observers may not vote and cannot provide comments on individual plants during judging.

Plants entered for ribbon judging must have been in the exhibitor's possession and care for at least six months prior to the show. Plant will be disqualified if ownership is questioned.

Virus suspected, diseased and insect-infested plants will be immediately removed from the show area and the owner of the plant will be asked to remove the plant from the premises. It will not be allowed back into the show, no exceptions.

Please keep your plants clean.

The Society is not responsible for damages to or loss of plants or related show items.

CLASSIFICATION OF EXHIBITORS:

Novice / Amateur: Has won no trophies in plant division of orchid shows.

Intermediate: Has won 1 to 9 trophies in plant division of orchid shows.

Advanced: Has won 10 or more trophies in plant division of orchid shows.

Open / Commercial: (A) One who grows and/or sells orchid plants/flowers as a business; (B) One who has bought space to sell orchid plants or flowers at more than two orchid events, shows, sales, benefits, Farmers' Markets, etc. in the 12 months prior to the date of this show excluding sales at orchid society monthly general membership meetings.
